Reading

We are learning to:

- Use phonics knowledge to decode new text fluently.
- Picture characters, settings and events.
- Use a range of punctuation to help read with expression and understanding.

Maths

We are learning to:

- Understand numbers to 1000.
- Find 1, 20 or 100 more or less.
- Add and subtract 1, 10, and 100 to numbers with exchanges.
- Use inverse operations.
- Estimate answers.

Geography

We are learning to:

- Name and locate Italy and some key Italian cities
- Identify human and physical characteristics of cities studied
- Recognising similarities and differences between our region of the UK
- Compare geographical locations in Italy and their human and physical features.

Science

We are learning to:

- Recognise that we need light in order to see things.
- Notice that light is reflected from surfaces
- Recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous.
- Recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object

Computing

We are learning to:

- Plan a book trailer.
- Take photos or videos that tell a story.
- Edit a video
- Add text and transitions to a video.
- Evaluate video editing.
