These children have large equipment in their own playgrounds to use during the school day.

## **School Uniform**

A letter came out last week about uniform. Please ensure your child wears school uniform. We also have rules regarding hair styles and would ask that no large bows or hair accessories are worn (for health and safety reasons) and that hair accessories are green or black, in line with the uniform. Hair should not be coloured, have shaved patterns or be extreme styles.

Please also note that only one pair of stud ear-rings should be worn. Hooped or hanging ear-rings or any other forms of jewellery should not be worn—again for health and safety reasons.
