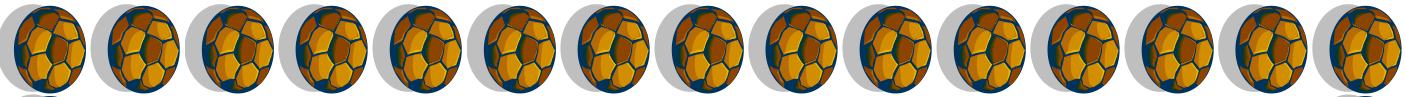




Cross Country Tournament



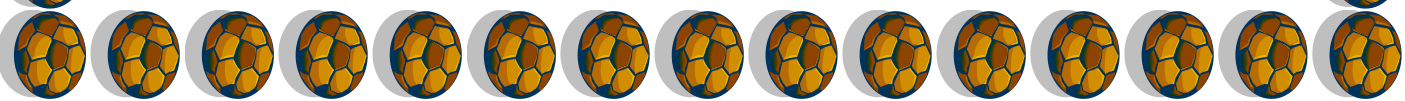
