The award grants Eyres Monsell gold status and recognises that the school has put a number of measures in place to help ensure the wellbeing of both pupils and staff.


Ward Councillor Virginia Cleaver has contacted the school to congratulate us and will be visiting next week, to see the amazing work being undertaken.
