

# Eyres Monsell Primary School: 2014 Pupil Premium Report

**Green – Very high achievement vs National** **Yellow – High achievement vs National**

**White – Average achievement vs National** **Red – Low achievement vs National**

The Pupil Premium is allocated to all schools and is based upon numbers of children from low-income families who are currently known to be eligible for free school meals (FSM) and children who have been looked after continuously for more than six months or have been in receipt of free school meals within the past six years.

At Eyres Monsell, our Pupil Premium allocation for 2014/15 is approximately £132,000. Expenditure for 2014/15 is on the pupil premium plan.

Irrespective of ability, we recognise the importance of ensuring this funding is specifically used for any child who has had FSM in the last six years and ‘looked after’ children at Glen Hills and, although our pupil premium pupils achieve and progress above the national average levels, we continually strive to see this improvement continue and the ‘gap narrowed’.

Our assessment of the quality of this provision will be based on continual monitoring and regular progress meetings with the teachers of the small groups.
