



# The Big Draw (Paul Klee)



## Top facts

- Paul Klee was born on 18<sup>th</sup> December 1879 in Switzerland, but considered a German citizen.
- He was inspired by Cubism and Robert Delaunay's brave use of colour. Klee started to experiment with colour and define his own style.
- Klee's style does not fall into one artistic movement - he borrows from Cubism, Surrealism and Expressionism.
- He finished more than 9000 pieces of art in his lifetime.

Surrealism	Artists create strange creatures from everyday objects.	Interpretation	The action of explaining the meaning of something.

Influential	Something or someone who impacts or shapes how things occur	Analyse	Examine something methodically and in detail.
