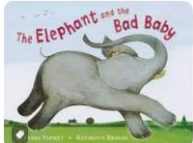


# Autumn One Term Year 1

### We are learning to:

Use our phonic knowledge to help decode words

Make predictions from the front cover and pictures

Become familiar with key stories and retell them

## Maths

### We are learning to:

- Sort and count objects
- Represent objects using counters and ten frames
- Recognise numbers as words
- Count on from any number
- Introduce parts and wholes
- Write number sentences

## Art

### We are learning to:

- Explore line, pattern and colour through marking making with different media i.e. Crayons, chalks, pens and pencils
- Create repeating patterns with lines, shapes and colours

## Science

### We are learning to:

- Observe changes across the four seasons (autumn)
- Observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.



## Geography

### We are learning to:

- Name and locate some places in their locality, the UK and wider world.
- Follow directions (Up, down, left/right, forwards/backwards)
- Use a simple picture map to move around the school.
- Express our views, likes and dislikes on some features of our environment.

## Music

### We are learning to:

- Hear and make long and short sounds on a variety of instruments
- Use our listening skills to identify different sounds
- To follow and create signals when performing
- How the pulse helps us to keep in time when performing music

### We are learning to:

- Understand my rights and responsibilities
- Know my views are valued and can contribute them
- Recognise the choices I make and understand the consequences

## RE

### We are learning to:

- Christianity and Judaism-Listen and talk about special and sacred stories
- Understand how stories help people make sense of the world
- Express our ideas about what stories from different religions teach us about God

- Run, jump, change direction, dodge and change speed when playing a game
